ABOUT KENYA

- Population: **46 million**
- Children under the age of 18 make up 49% of Kenya's total population.
- Over 75% of Kenya's children live without safe water, proper nutrition, and health services.
- An estimated **2-3 million** orphaned children live in Kenya.

The Future of Into Abba's Arms

Two years ago, God led us to begin plans to provide for more children. At the time, we had no idea the need would become so critical. The current crisis facing Kenya's orphans makes the need for new dorms and expanded facilities more urgent than ever.

Our plan for expansion includes the completion of:

- **Two dorms providing housing for 130+ additional children**
- **Chapel addition with Sunday school classrooms**
- **Basketball court**
- **Staff housing**
- **Covered Pavilion**

We hope to complete the building project in 2020. Total cost for this building program is **\$400,000**, to progress as the funds come in.

- **\$50,000 to furnish the buildings**
- **Hiring staff to accommodate the new children**




